### Howletts Lane Swan Reach

*Paramatta Grass (Sporobolus africanus), also known as Rat's Tail Grass, is a coarse tufted perennial that has low nutritive value for grazing stock. It prefers growing in low soil fertility conditions and can limit the productivity of paddocks.*
